### RULES/REQUIREMENTS

1. Teachers may enter only students who are currently studying with them and have studied the performance medium of the audition with the entering teacher a minimum of 6 of the 9 months immediately preceding the day on which the district auditions are held.
2. Any previous state winner of an MTNA Competition or state winner of the Buckeye State Auditions may not enter in the same instrument category of level, but may enter in a different instrument category of level when eligible.
3. Teacher must be OMTA member or will have to pay a non-member fee of \$25.00.
4. Pianists and vocalists must have music memorized.
5. Contestants must provide judges with one copy of the published music without any identifying marks.
6. Students must provide own accompanists, and teachers may accompany their own students, but must not identify themselves to the judges.
7. The judges' decision is final. They do not have to declare a winner.
8. Students who win must compete in the state finals. The state winners must perform in the winners' concert held at the conclusion of the state auditions.
9. Auditions are open to the public.
10. There will be no ties at any level. The alternate may appear in the state finals if the district winner is unable to appear.
11. Photography is not allowed and video/audio taping is strongly discouraged.
12. **All Divisions must program two contrasting pieces. Senior Division: one of the pieces must be a classical composition.**
13. Time Limitations:     Senior           9-18 minutes  
                                  Junior           6-12 minutes  
                                  Elementary   5-10 minutes

### DISQUALIFICATIONS

Those who fall short of the time limitations or who do not follow guidelines will be disqualified.
